

Terms of Reference
Appointment of an expert in terms of Section 21 of the CBE Act of 2000.

Background of the Council for the Built Environment

The Council for the Built Environment (CBE), located in Pretoria, is a statutory body established in terms of the Council for the Built Environment Act (No. 43 of 2000). It is an overarching body that coordinates the six Professional Councils (architecture, engineering, landscape architects, project and construction management, property valuation and quantity surveying). The CBE is bound by its mandate to ensure sustainable built environment professions which serve public and national interest. It is also mandated to advice government on human resources development within the built environment sector.

The CBE is mandated to act as an appellate body for decisions emanating from the six Professional Councils. In terms of Section 21(c) of the CBE Act a person specializing in the professional field concerning the appeal must be appointed as one of the members of the Appeal Committee.

The CBE requests that individuals who qualify in terms of the qualification criteria mentioned below to submit C.V's for consideration and appointment as members of the Appeal Committee.

Qualification criteria

Qualification

An applicant must be registered with a built environment council as one of the following:

- 1. Professional Architect
- 2. Professional Senior Architectural Technologist
- 3. Professional Architectural Technologist
- 4. Professional Architectural Draughtsperson
- 5. Professional Construction Manager
- 6. Professional Construction Project Manager
- 7. Professional Quantity Surveyor
- 8. Professional Valuer
- Professional Mechanical Engineer
- 10. Professional Civil Engineer
- 11. Professional Geotechnical Engineer

Legislative knowledge

Applicant must demonstrate an understanding of the CBE Act and the relevant Built Environment Profession Act.

Analytical Ability

Applicant must demonstrate an ability to write an opinion based on oral and/or written evidence submissions.

Experience

Applicant must have at least seven (7) years post professional registration experience.

Independent from the Built Environment Professional Council

Applicant must not be a member in any of the Built Environment Professional Council or be serving in any committee of the Professional Council.
