

- CESA's recommended alternative to other FOA's


**◆**Purpose of form of agreement

To provide a model contract that contains the essential parts of a sub-consultancy agreement so that the risk of each party is balanced and limited.




#### **◆ Highlights**


- Section 4.4 Force Majeure: Provides way forward after unexpected circumstances
- Section 5.2 Set-off: Excluded
- Section 6.3 Duration of Liability: 3 years
- Section 6.4 Limit of Compensation: 2 x amount
- Section 6.5 Insurance for Liability and Indemnity: PI Insurance required for liability period
- Section 7.9 Variations: Important clause for change management
- Section 8 Settlement of disputes: Does not include adjudication





