- ❖ The current network is a valuable asset not only to the North West Province, but also has direct benefits to the neighbouring provinces such as Northern Cape, Free State, Gauteng, Mpumalanga and Limpopo.
- ❖ The Province also forms corridors to other neighbouring Countries such as Botswana and Namibia

Role or opportunities for Consulting Engineers

- ❖ North West Provincial Road Network is approximately 19783 km in total, of which 14 700km remain unpaved and 5083km is paved (RAMS).
- ❖ The province have very high demand of office accommodation, schools, libraries, hospital and clinics that requires capable innovative consulting engineers that can plan, design and implement infrastructure.
- ❖ Due to insufficient technical capacity and system majority of this work is outsourced to private sector (Consulting Engineers) for planning, design and supervision of the work at implementation stage.
