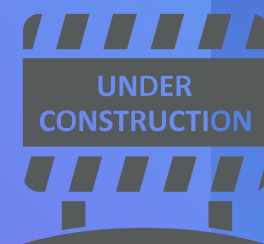
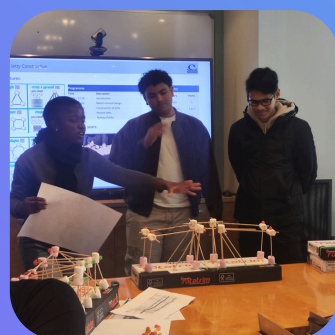




PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE
